There has to have been a moment at which the Church came into existence; it was when the Apostles became aware of the Spirit, who had been working, unknown, since the beginning of creation, as a gift of God. This may not have been fifty days after the Resurrection, as Luke describes it; John's Gospel puts the gift of the Spirit on Easter day. It doesn't matter. We tend to divide God up according to a historical sequence: a bearded patriarch, a baby boy, a dove. But the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are eternal, before even creation began, and humanity has always lived in the Trinity. Eastertide is brought to an end today, but Christ will always be risen, the Father will always be filling the earth with riches, and it is the Spirit that empowers us to say both of these things (including 'Come, Holy Spirit' at any time). The Tongues of Fire event was a passing aspect of Pentecost. It is what followed that, the gift of speech to preach the message, which is the enduring fruit of the Spirit. See what is said there about Love. This is one of the gifts of the Spirit.
