The point of using the non-biblical word 'Trinity' is that the New Testament is full of language which talks of Abba, Father; the Spirit; and Jesus the Son. After the Resurrection the disciples fall down before him - though some, like Thomas, hesitate. Jesus is now worthy of worship, no longer appearing to them as simply a man. The trinitarian words Jesus uses are found only here in the Bible. The Second Reading shows how this language actually relates to how God works in us: we are co-heirs with Christ, sharing in his glory; and, like the Son, we are filled with the Spirit and empowered to cry out Abba Father. And the picture isn't complete until we put ourselves in the picture as well. We cannot imagine God alone; all we know is God and humankind, 'all that the Lord your God did for you' as the Reading says. We only know God, and can only know God, as the kind and loving creator.- this is expressed in the Psalm response. And we are eternal, like God, who will be with us to the end of time, and beyond.
