### **USING OUR VOTE**

The Bishops of England and Wales have issued a letter to Catholics on the forthcoming general election, which will be available this weekend. Copies can be found at:

The letter is an encouragement to all Catholics to play an active part in the election. While voting for any particular political party is a matter of conscience, the bishops encourage people to use their vote at this pivotal time for our nations, as we prepare to leave the European Union. The letter lays out broad principles to guide our thinking in the run-up to the election, taken from Pope Francis' *Evangelii Gaudium*. The letter then moves from these broad guiding principles to some more specific questions for consideration and to raise with candidates, including questions on how best to encourage and enable families to flourish, promote freedom of religion across the world and care for refugees and asylum seekers. The letter concludes with a prayer:

'Lord grant us wisdom to act always with integrity, seeking the protection and flourishing of all, and building a society based on justice and peace.'

Churches together in Harpenden have arranged an 'Election Hustings' with the candidates for the parliamentary constituency of Hitchin and Harpenden. This will take place on Monday, 5<sup>th</sup> June, 8pm at High Street Methodist.

The 'Growing in Faith' campaign is continuing in the Diocese. Presently 148 parishioners are supporting this initiative, and £210,647, which includes Gift Aid of £32,060, has been contributed. This money will be used as follows: Sick & Retired Priests, 40%: £84,259, Caritas Westminster, 20%: £42,129, Training of Priests 18%: £37,916, Post-Ordination Training, 2%: £4,213, Parish Project, 20%: £42,129.
