The gospel today introduces us to a man who is clearly in the midst of a struggle. He *runs* up and *kneels* before Jesus. This tells us a lot about him. He is obviously a sincere, good-living man. He has recognised who Jesus is, and so he asks him: *“Good Master, what must I do to inherit eternal life?”*

It's a great question which not everyone is capable of asking. The man had obviously already made significant progress. Together with his great love for God this man showed great love for his neighbour and when Jesus tells him to keep the commandments he is able to look Jesus in the eye and say: *“Master, I have kept all these from my earliest days.”* But there was one thing he lacked. Jesus tells him: *“Go and sell everything you own and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven”.*

The man is sad, his face fell at the invitation. He was a wealthy man and he loved his wealth very much, too much. His relationship with the material world was still out of kilter with the call to discipleship that Jesus was making, probably without the man realising it, despite his goodness, he had put God in a subordinate position to his wealth.

Of course, we don't know how the story ended. The young man may have adjusted to Jesus' radical demand and found the grace to say that difficult yes. Maybe he heeded those words from the book of Wisdom: *“I prayed, and understanding was given me; I entreated, and the spirit of Wisdom came to me”.*
