## 'INTERCESSORY PRAYER AND HEALTH':

A talk by The Rev'd Professor Nick Goulding - Diocese of St Alban's, Advisor for Faith and Science. Saturday, 18<sup>th</sup> May, 11 am, St Nicholas Church Hall.
