Today in Rome Pope Francis will Canonise a native of our Diocese, and the first Englishman to be canonised since the Forty Martyrs of England and Wales in 1970.

John Henry Newman was born in Ealing on February 21, 1801. His father was a banker of Evangelical religious beliefs. At the age of 15 Newman experienced a religious "conversion" that was the foundation of his lifelong intense faith in God. He studied in Oxford, and graduated in 1821. He was ordained in the Church of England in 1824, became a curate in Oxford, and tutor at Oriel. He was received into the Roman Catholic Church in 1845. In 1846 Newman went to Rome and was ordained a priest. He joined the Oratorian order, and returned to England to found the Oratory in Birmingham, and later the London Oratory.

One of the most important aspects of his life is the long and difficult journey he made into the fullness of faith in the Catholic Church. It cost him dearly. Yet it is an essential part of his witness. His search for truth led him to examine in detail the foundations of the Catholic faith in the history of the Church. It also drove him to look closely at his own experiences, and feelings, sensing in them the call and promptings of God. This sense made him a wonderful witness to the nature, importance, and experience of the Catholic faith.

Although a great teacher of the faith Cardinal Newman had a great concern for the poor. Thousands lined the streets of Birmingham to demonstrate their love and respect to him when he died. Today we rejoice at a new English saint, and we pray that we may be inspired by him, to know and love our faith.

A NEW SAINT

To mark the Canonisation of St John Henry Newman, there are a number of events taking place in the Diocese:

The London Oratory will celebrate the canonisation on **Thursday 17th**



October at 6.30pm with Solemn Pontifical Mass, celebrated by Cardinal Nichols. On **Saturday 19th October**, at 3.30pm, there will be Solemn Ecumenical Vespers in Westminster Cathedral, with the Archbishop of Canterbury preaching. No tickets are necessary for this event, the cathedral will remain open while seats are available.
