CHURCH REOPENING

We received the good news last Sunday that churches can reopen for private prayer, subject to certain strict conditions, from tomorrow, Monday 15th June. This is wonderful news that, although opening times are limited, there is still the opportunity to come and pray in church, or simply to come and find some peace and solace. Thank you to those generous people who have kindly agreed to act as stewards, and to clean the church after each opening. Given the number of volunteers we have, we plan to open:

Sunday: 8.30am to 10.30am.
Monday: 9.00am to 10.30am
Tuesday: 5.30pm to 6.30pm
Wednesday: 9.00am to 10.30am
Thursday: 5.30pm to 6.30pm
Friday: Closed
Saturday: 10.00am to 11.30am & 5.30pm to 6.30pm

If you are thinking of visiting the church, please note:

- ❖ You must not enter if you, or a member of your household, have displayed any of the symptoms related to CO-VID19.
- ❖ It is strongly advised that you do not enter if you fall within an 'at risk' group (over 70, asthmatic or have underlying medical conditions).

When you come to church, please:

- ❖ On arriving, cleanse your hands with the sanitiser provided.
- ❖ Maintain social distancing.
- ❖ No physical contact with others, no handshakes or hugs!
- ❖ Follow the 'one way' system.
- ❖ Only sit in the seats that are marked, by a green tick.
- ❖ Leave the church following the 'one way' system.
- ❖ As you leave, cleanse your hands with the sanitiser provided.

Please note that, as instructed, the toilets are not available

I know the above guidelines sound very prescriptive, but as we all know they are there for everyone's safety and health. I hope you will take the opportunity to visit the church, where you can feel at home and welcome.

PARISH LIFE CONTINUES

How good that we can open our church again, albeit for short periods, and of course Mass continues to be celebrated. The church, to some degree, being used what it is there for. The life of the parish continues in, albeit, different ways. Some groups are meeting virtually, and others are giving support to some of those who are confined to their homes. 


support of women in Kenya trying to set up their own small businesses and so become self-sufficient. Thanks, and prayers to all.

SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

In the present circumstances, we cannot receive Holy Communion but we can make a **Spiritual Communion**. Set aside some time either alone, or better with your family. Turn off the tv or radio.

Firstly: Make the sign of the Cross.

Then: Make an act of Contrition.

Then say: *My Jesus, I believe that You are in the Blessed Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I long for You in my soul. Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. As though You have already come, I embrace You and unite myself entirely to You; never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.*

Finish by making the **Sign of The Cross**

NEWSPAPERS & DAY BY DAY BOOKS


The Universe Newspaper is available from the Presbytery Front Garden. The newspaper costs £1.50 and there is an honesty box for you to use.
