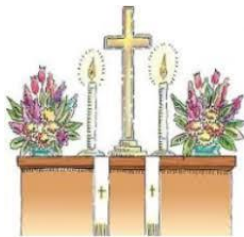

HARPENDEN JIGSAW FESTIVAL



We and High Street Methodist Church (HSMC) are working together to organise this festival on 4-5 June 2021. Half of the proceeds will go to Workaid, a charity in Chesham, which collects unwanted tools, refurbishes them and then ships them to training centres, prisons and self-help organisations in some of the world's most disadvantaged communities.

(In October 2019 the DWG and Live Simply organised a successful tool collection for Workaid.) The other half will be directed to Azalea, a Luton-based charity which reaches out to those trapped in sexual exploitation, helping them to build new lives away from violence and poverty.
