The Sacraments mark out significant moments, in the life of the Church, and in our life of faith. Since the lockdown the life of the Church, as with so many other aspects of life, has been drastically curtailed. We have been deprived of these special moments, not least our participation, in the celebration of the Eucharist. It has been good since July to be able to celebrate Mass again, albeit with limited numbers. And it has also been good, to celebrate Baptisms and marriages, again in limited ways.

The last four weeks have been very busy, and that has been good, it brings a certain feeling of normality, doing what we are here to do. Over these weeks there have been five Masses, during which 66 children made their First Holy Communion, and three Masses with 40 of our young people being Confirmed. The fact that the celebrations had to be delayed added to the specialness of the celebrations, even though we were limited in what could be done. It has been good since then to hear the positive comments from some of those who attended. Thanks are due to all our Catechists, as well as members of the choir, and those who did the live-streaming, and the flowers.

We are fortunate to have been able to live-stream Masses, as well as some of those recent special occasions, and weddings and funerals, but, I'm sure we would agree that this is no substitute for being present together, and receiving the Lord's Body and Blood. How the future will evolve, we don't know, but we can look forward with faith, and with our First Communicants, and Confirmandi, may we all grow in our love of Jesus in the Eucharist, and be open the power, and presence, of the Holy Spirit.


