Today, we begin the great Season of Advent. There are two messages that we will hear over the next four weeks. One message and set of values will come to us from the media and the shops, telling us that unless we spend, we won't be happy! This most definitely is 'fake news.' However, there is a very different message offered to us through the gospels, and the liturgy of Advent. We are being asked to prepare a way for the Lord, to stay awake, to make a straight a path for the Lord and to get ourselves ready to celebrate the birth of Jesus. This is most definitely is 'Good News! We are called to be ready, to be prepared and to wait in joyful hope.

Modern life, with it's technology, doesn't make us good at waiting. We expect things to happen in an instant. However, Advent asks each of us to do the very opposite. During this time of preparation, we are being asked to take some time to be still and silent as we prepare for Christmas. We may not be able to ignore the shops, and the advertisements over the next few weeks, neither can we ignore the words and message of Jesus in today's gospel: *'Be on your guard, stay awake, because you never know when the time will come... what I say to you I say to all: Stay awake!'*

We are to stay awake, to focus on what is important. We are called not to ignore Advent. But, rather to prepare, and get ready as best we can. It would be so sad, that if after the shopping and all the other preparations we missed Advent and its joyful and hopeful message.

In what ways can I prepare a way for the Lord this Advent as I get ready to celebrate the birth of Jesus at Christmas?

## CELEBRATING MASS AGAIN

As the second lockdown ends so, it is most certainly good news, that we can begin, once again, to celebrate Mass with a congregation. **We will be re-starting next Wednesday, December 2<sup>nd</sup>.** Masses will continue to be celebrated at the same times, as we have been doing until recently: Saturday 5.00pm, Sunday 9.00am and 10.30am; Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday at 9.15am. The Sunday 10.30am Mass, and the Masses on Tuesday and Thursday, will continue to be live-streamed. If you wish to attend any of these Masses please let us know. ## DON'T FORGET

- Wear a mask, or face covering

- Avoid touching surfaces
- Limit interactions with anyone you are not attending church with.

## FIRST COMMUNION 2021

At last we are now in a position to begin to register children, in year 3 and above, for First Holy Communion in 2021. If you would like to register your child you will find the form on the parish website, alternatively you can request a form by contacting the parish office. Completed forms and copies of Baptism Certificates should be returned no later than December 14<sup>th</sup>. Dates for preparation, and First Communion celebrations, have still to be decided, and will be advised, with further information, during January. **NB** if your child was Baptised in Our Lady of Lourdes Harpenden you do not need to send us a copy of their Baptism Certificate.



## STAYING IN TOUCH

During the first lockdown, a number of dedicated



volunteers attempted to make contact with as many parishioners as possible. This was very successful, and much appreciated. With the second lockdown now coming to an end, and with Christmas approaching, we are very conscious that it is likely that there will be some

## RECEPTION REFERENCES



Parents who need the Certificate of Catholic Practice (CCP) completed, are asked to drop the form into the presbytery, enclosing a stamped addressed envelope. Canon Dwyer will


complete the forms, as appropriate, and, will as necessary, make contact by telephone or virtually. A copy of the CCP can be provided but, for it to be completed, parents will need to provide the full name, address and date of birth of the child. **Although the closing date for applications is January 15<sup>th</sup>, it would be very helpful if parents could send the CCP for completion by the beginning of December.**

### **MASS STIPENDS**

The question is sometimes asked: what the appropriate amount to donate is, when requesting a Mass to be offered? In Westminster Diocese, the guidance is that the suggested offering is £10. The offering, contributes to the upkeep of the priest, who celebrates the Mass, but doesn't receive a set salary. In earlier times, the Mass Stipend was seen as keeping a priest for a day.



**Quite a number of Masses have been booked during the pandemic, but no stipend has yet been received. Stipends, stating the intention and date requested, can be placed through the presbytery letter box.**

### **PRAYING TOGETHER**



It has been good to hear from parishioners that they have taken up the invitation to pray together as a family, every evening at 7.30pm, and, so for those unable to attend Mass, to still be united. It has been suggested that Canon Dwyer, and others, might lead this


