Once again, we find ourselves in lockdown, and it's not the easiest of experiences. And a sad consequence of this is that Public Worship has again been suspended. It is a great sadness that we cannot gather as a community, to celebrate Mass together. Many people find the live-streaming helpful, and it has been good that we are able to do so. But of course, it is not the same as gathering as a community, and receiving the Body of Christ.

Since the churches reopened, at the beginning of July, parishioners have generously volunteered to steward, and to clean the church, so, ensuring that it is a safe place to be. So, it is disappointing, when the churches have been so responsible, that the Government has forbidden public worship. What is their decision based on? What evidence is there, that churches are unsafe places? Churches, it seems, come under the heading of non-essential services, what a lack of understanding that demonstrates! Churches, and faith, are lifelines for many people.

In a message, at the weekend, the Cardinal suggests we write to our MP's, so that they know our opinions on this matter. I know a number of you have done so, and it would be good if others were to do so.

Once again then, we are without the Eucharist, but we are not without our faith. We can live and celebrate our faith, in our homes, as families and as individuals; and we can still keep Sunday special, not least by following the Mass on live-streaming. And we can deepen our faith by making time to pray together, perhaps to read the scriptures, maybe to make contact with someone who is lonely, or in need. In these lockdown days, we are still the Church, at the moment, the domestic Church, the Church of the Home.

MASS AND PRAYER

With public worship banned it is, sadly, not possible to celebrate Mass with a congregation. However, Mass will be live-streamed on Sundays at 10.30am, and on Tuesdays and Thursday at 9.15am. We are permitted to open the church for private prayer. The church will be open Wednesday's between 10.00am and 11.00am; and it will also be open on Saturdays, from Saturday 14th, between 5.00pm and 6.00pm, when the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed, and this will be live-streamed, see 'Livestreaming' for details.
