10.00pm\* Mass During the Night

### Christmas DAY

9.00am, 10.30am\* & 12noon Masses of Christmas Day

If, for any reason, you find you are unable to use the places, you have requested, please be sure to inform the Parish Office, as soon as you can. The demand for places is high, and it would be a great shame if any were to go unused.

### PLEASE NOTE

Thank you to everyone who completed the survey, asking whether you plan to attend a Christmas Mass, here or not? Please note that this was just a survey, **not a booking for any of the Christmas Masses.**

Requests for places can only be made via the website or parish office.

Details of everything taking place, in church, until the New Year, will be found in the Christmas leaflet. If you receive the newsletter by email, hopefully you have received a copy. If not, you can collect one from the church porch, or a copy can be emailed, or posted, if you contact the parish office.

### DON'T FORGET

When you come to Mass, you are asked to:

- Wear a mask, or face covering
- Follow the stewards' instructions
- Sanitise your hands on entering and leaving the church
- Observe social distancing of 2m
- Follow the one-way system around the church
- Sit in a pre-allocated seat
- Avoid touching surfaces
- Limit interactions with anyone you are not attending church with.

## CAROL SERVICE

Our Parish Carol Service takes place this evening at 6.00pm, albeit a little differently this year, with just the Choir and Readers in church. The service will be live-streamed, **Zoom Code 883 0772 7862.**

## EPIPHANY

The Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord takes place on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January, returning to its traditional place, Twelfth Night. Usually this would be a Holyday of Obligation, but not this year as the obligation is presently suspended. However, there will be two Masses on that day, 9.15am and 6.00pm.



## VISITS TO THE CRIB

Usually around Christmas it is possible to leave the church open and, whoever wishes, can come and visit the crib. This year, that is not possible.



However, in order to allow individuals and families to make such visits, the church will be open, outside of Mass, on three occasions. Please see the Christmas leaflet for details.

## CHRISTMAS OFFERING

The offering on Christmas Day contributes towards the upkeep of priests who work in parishes. For many of us this is a strange year, and particularly for those who may have lost jobs, or had income reduced; as happened to parish clergy last Easter when, because of lockdown, the collection was significantly less than usual. Those who support the parish, using the planned giving envelopes, will find a 'Christmas offering envelope', amongst their envelopes. Parishioners who support the parish in other ways, may wish to use one of the Christmas envelopes that will be found in the church porch. Contributions will be collected at the Christmas Masses, and can also be dropped into the presbytery letter box. Your support, in so many ways, is much appreciated.

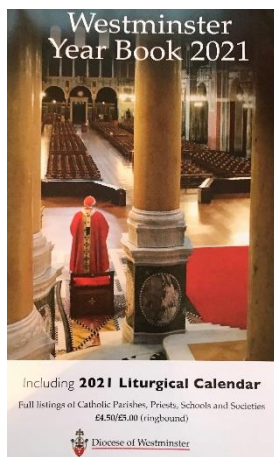
## CATHOLIC PAPERS

## THE DEVELOPING WORLD GROUP

The Developing World Group has recently donated £1650 to the International Refugee Trust (IRT) to enable the Sacred Heart Sisters who run the Moyo Babies' Home on northern Uganda to replace machinery and equipment ( a paste grinding machine , strimmer and chain saw) which were beyond repair. This will save the costs of hiring equipment and labour. It will thus release funds to help the babies and children in the home, who have been displaced from South Sudan and other parts of northern Uganda. ## COVID-19 VACCINATION - CALL FOR LOCAL VOLUNTEERS.

The Harpenden Trust has just been asked by the local GP Federation to coordinate volunteer support for them during the forthcoming Covid-19 vaccination programme across the local Harpenden community. This will take place at a central Harpenden location with effect from Monday 21<sup>st</sup> December, requiring two outdoor marshals, six indoor patient support volunteers and four administration support personnel each day, for up to six days per week. The programme will be stretching into Spring next year. Viewed in "half days" - it is anticipated that 100 and approaching 150 volunteers will be needed each week to support our local community Covid vaccination programme.

There is some immediate time pressure, as it needs to be established if this volunteer workforce can be established. 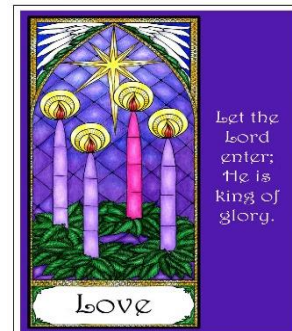
