PRIEST'S TRAINING FUND

Thank you to everyone who contributed to the recent collection for the Priest Training Fund. The formation of priests is of top priority, and this fund provides for the training of those preparing to serve as priests in our diocese.

CELEBRATING MASS TOGETHER

Over the past year, especially when it was not possible to celebrate Mass together, it was very good that we could participate via the live-streaming. Now though, as we begin to return to some sort of normality, it's very important that, unless we're prevented from doing so for health reasons, that we begin to gather together again for the celebration of Mass.

The Bishop's of England and Wales have written about the need to celebrate Mass together, included in their reflection:

"It is the Eucharist, the celebration of the Mass, that makes the Church; and it is the Church, in the gift of the Holy Spirit, which makes the Eucharist.

The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the lifeblood of the Church. It requires our active participation and, to be fully celebrated, our physical presence.

"At this moment, then, we need to have in our sights the need to restore to its rightful centrality in our lives the Sunday Mass, encouraging each to take his or her place once again in the assembly of our brothers and sisters.

"We face the task of seeking to nurture the sense of Sunday as 'a weekly gift from God to his people', and something we cannot do without; to see Sunday as the soul of the week, as giving light and meaning to all the responsibilities we live out each day; to see the Sunday Eucharist as food for the unique mission with which we have been endowed."
