Today's Gospel provides us with an important insight into God's thinking. We are confronted with the attitude of God to the wrongdoer, His deep desire to forgive, to be totally reconciled with the one who has severed relations with Him. The emphasis is less on the son than on the attitude of the father.

No one can deny the appalling behaviour of the younger son. He took all that his father generously gave to him as his inheritance and used it in leading a life of total debauchery and self-centred indulgence. Eventually, he had nothing and was reduced to living with pigs, even sharing their food, something utterly abhorrent to the Jewish mind. The son, it might be said, brought it on himself.

This, however, is not the reaction of the father, who has only one thought in his mind - how to get his son to come back to where he belongs. The father does not say: "This son has seriously offended me and brought disgrace on our family." Instead, he says: "My son went away, is lost and I want so much to have him back." And he stands at the door of His house watching and waiting. His love for his wayward son never wavers, not one iota.

In wanting to experience God's forgiveness, we also need to learn how to be forgiving to others. Do we set limits to our forgiveness? To be reconciled with God we need to learn how to be reconciled with all those who are sources of conflict or pain in our lives. As we continue to learn how to forgive, we thank God that we have a Lord who is always ready to forgive, and to welcome, us back again and again.



FRIDAYS IN LENT

Friday is always a significant day, as we recall the Passion and Death of the Lord; and this is particularly so on the Fridays of Lent. **Each Friday during Lent, Mass will be celebrated at 7.00pm, and will be followed by the Stations of the Cross.**

CHILDREN'S STATIONS OF THE CROSS

Our children's Stations of the Cross will be at 11.30am on Good Friday 15th April, and will last about 45 minutes. This is a really good opportunity for children to understand and take part in Christ's Passion on Good Friday.

We are looking for children to take parts in the form of a tableau for each station. The children have to be from years 3 to 6, to take part. We need about 10 actors (no speaking parts), who will have to be in church from 9:30am on Good Friday. We will do the rehearsal, have a small break, and then perform our Stations of the Cross at 11.30am. This allows any other family members to join in The Walk of Witness in the town, and then join us in church.

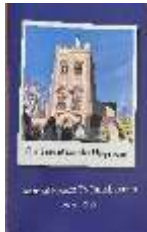

PRAYER FOR UKRAINE

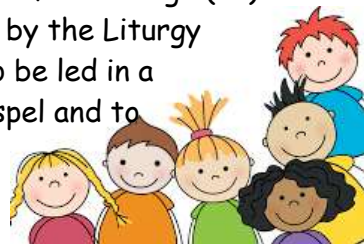
