Every Palm Sunday, as we listen to the reading of the Passion, so, once again, we begin our Holy Week journey. As we listen to that reading it is as if the route, we are to travel, is being set out before us. We remember the journey that Jesus travelled, through his passion, to his death on the cross; we are not just to be spectators, or simply recalling an historical event, but we are to be participants, participants in the Lord's Passion and death.

One Spiritual writer, describes our Holy Week journey as being like a ship. She writes: "This great ship of Holy week will carry us surely, strongly, into the Passion of Christ..... All we have to do now is board the ship and allow it to take us all way. We have nothing else to do but let it take us. We have not to do the navigating ourselves, we have not to labour with the oars, we have not to see where we are going or what distance we are covering: all that is being done for us. we have only to say 'Let it be done. Give me all you want to give. Be my Saviour, be my God'"

We make our Holy week journey, not alone but, as part of our parish community, and in union with the whole Church. For the first time in two years, there are, almost, no restrictions, on what we do, or on numbers. Everyone is welcome to participate, to seize the opportunity, to make this special journey. During Lent we've been encouraged to invite those who have yet to return to Mass, to do so. Who have you invited, encouraged? You can still do so and, especially for the coming week, together we can journey through Holy Week, celebrating the great mysteries of our faith.



PALM SUNDAY

Today, Palm Sunday, we begin our Holy Week Journey to Easter. Details of everything happening in Holy Week, will be found in the Holy week leaflet, which has been emailed to everyone, whose email addresses we have. Copies are available, though, in the porch. Do think about participating in the events of Holy Week, as much as you can. Although some adjustments have had to be made, we are so fortunate to be back in church, celebrating together this most important of weeks. The main events are:

MONDAY

Penitential Service at 7.30pm. An opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and to make that all-important preparation for Easter.

MAUNDY THURSDAY

- Mass of the Lord's Supper at 8.00pm. We gather to celebrate the institution of the gift of the Eucharist, and to recall the Lord's great example of service, as he washes the feet of his disciples.
- Afterwards, there is watching at the Altar of Repose until 11.00pm. Jesus asks 'can you not watch one hour with me?'

GOOD FRIDAY

- The Walk of Witness, with other Harpenden churches take place today. 10.15am assemble at Rothamsted Park gates, for departure at 10.30am. The walk concludes with a short service on Church Green.
- At 3.00pm, with sorrow and gratitude, we come together to recall the Passion and Death of the Lord.
- At 7.30pm there is 'Prayer before the Crucifix'.

HOLY SATURDAY

- As we await the great celebration of Easter, we gather in church, for Morning Prayer, at 11.00am.
- In the evening at 8.30pm we celebrate the most important event, in the Church's year, the Easter Vigil.

EASTER SUNDAY

Masses will be celebrated at 8.30am, 9.45am and 11.30am.

The offertory on Easter Day, along with the Christmas offertory, is for the clergy of the parish. Together with Mass Stipends and Stole fees, this collection forms an essential part of clergy income. Envelopes for your contributions, will be found in the porch.

CANCELLED

It's usual each year, on Good Friday, to have the Stations of the Cross for the children. Sadly, this year the Stations for the Children will not take place, as no children, or families, have volunteered to participate. Good Friday is one of the most solemn days in the Church's year, it is to be hoped that families with children will be observing this Holy day in an appropriate way. Easter holidays are often spoken of. It's worth remembering that the original reason for these holidays, was so that the people could attend the Holy Week and Easter celebrations.

At the beginning of Lent the Cardinal suggested we might encourage someone we know, who has not returned to the practice of attending Mass. As we start Holy Week, is there someone you might think of inviting? Until now who have you reached out to? Who
