**NEWS ON THE STAFFING OF OUR PARISH:** Fr James writes: Cardinal Vincent has asked Fr Chinedu to move in January to become Parish Priest at Tollington Park. Whilst this is unsettling, as Fr Chinedu has only recently come to Harrow South and Northolt, the greater needs of the diocese at a chaotic time emerging from the pandemic make it necessary. We will be very sorry to have to say goodbye to Fr Chinedu just as he was starting to settle down here and get to know people and we must support him in prayer at a challenging time.

There's no change at present to our pattern of Sunday Mass provision, and so the Cardinal is sending another assistant priest to enable this pattern. Fr Carlos Quito will be coming to us from Highbury in January. There'll be more details when we have them.

- Name of parents and full name of child.
- Date of birth of child.
- Residential Address
- Name of EACH school to which an application is being made.

As you will understand, following the normal criteria for issuing certificates, almost nobody would qualify. A modified process is being followed. After receipt of your email you will be contacted from the office.
