+ 1ST SUNDAY OF ADVENT - YEAR A

"Watch, therefore, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming." (Mt 24.42)

The Church begins her year with the holy season of Advent. At this time, she invites her children to prepare themselves so we can celebrate worthily Our Lord's entry in the flesh into our history, so that by our communion with Him in love, we can make our hearts fitting abodes of the divinity (Jn 14.23); thus, we can prepare ourselves for His glorious coming as our judge on the last day. At His first coming in the flesh, Our Lord came in weakness and humility, taking the form of a servant (Phil. 5.7); at His second coming, He will come with power and great glory (Mk 13.26). The first time He came, He was unknown and unwelcomed, even among His own people (Jn 1.11); when He comes again, all eyes will see Him (Rev. 1.7), and all things will be subject to Him (1 Cor. 15.27-28; Eph. 1.22; Phil. 3.21), and no one will be able to resist His authority. His first coming was full of His love and mercy for sinners, to get them to repent (Mk 2.17; Mt 9.13; Lk 5.32); He will come again, "not to deal with sin, but to save those who are eagerly waiting for Him" (Heb. 9.28). When He came the first time in the flesh, He allowed people to treat Him as they pleased; when He comes again in glory, He will call to judgement those who resisted His first coming, and reward everyone according to his or her deeds (Rom. 2.6). His first coming was to prepare us for eternal life; at His second coming in glory, He will bestow eternal life on those who by their faith and service are deserving of it. Therefore, all who await His coming in glory ought to sanctify their expectancy with their watchful service of love.
