## + 2<sup>ND</sup> SUNDAY OF ADVENT – YEAR A

"They shall not hurt or destroy in all My holy mountain." (Isaiah 11. 9)

Each year, Institute for Economics & Peace headquartered in Sydney, Australia, publishes its 'Global Peace Index'. This year's index shows for the first time since 2014 a slight improvement in the level of global peacefulness. While 86 countries showed some improvement, 75 others recorded deteriorations. Iceland maintains its enviable prime position as the most peaceful country in the world, with Afghanistan taking over from Syria as the least peaceful. Overall, the global level of peacefulness has decreased by 3.78% since 2008. What this tells us is that we are still a very long way from getting close to a principal goal of Our Lord's coming into the world, which is, that peace and harmony might reign amongst all peoples and nations. Our Lord came as the Prince of Peace (Is 9.6); He Himself is also "our peace, who has made us both one, and has broken down the wall of hostility . . ." (Eph. 2.14). He came and established in Himself Isaiah's vision of a world that is totally devoid of all conflict and hostility, including the ones that occur in nature, the vision of all creation perpetually living in peace and harmony (Is 11.6-9). That vision is not realisable in this life; but it does invite everyone to recognise and take full responsibility for his or her part in making the reign of peace in every heart, home, and society illusive, and to turn completely away from such behaviour through a true conversion of heart. That conversion is what St John the Baptist is inviting all of us to undergo by turning away from everything that is in any way hostile to God or to neighbour, and by bearing the fruits that befit true repentance (Mt 3.8).
