+ THE HOLY FAMILY - YEAR A

"Rise, take the Child and His mother . . . " (Mt 2.13)

On this solemn feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, we salute all our families. Together they form the larger family of God's people. Being a 'domestic Church' (LG, 11), each family is called to be a community of faith, hope, and charity, and finds its true meaning in the Holy Family of Nazareth. Constituted by 'members who are persons and equal in dignity', it is the oldest and most basic social institution established by God at the creation of man and woman (Gen. 1.27). As the original cell of social life where man and woman, united in marriage, are called to mutually communicate themselves in love and in the gift of life, it is the sign and image of 'the communion of the Father and the Son in the Spirit.' A privileged community that in procreation and the education of children reflects the Father's creative work, it creates an affinity of feelings, thoughts, affections, and interests. The 'authority, stability, and life of relationships within it' are 'the foundations of freedom, security, and fraternity in society.' In it education in the virtues (including self-denial, sound judgement, and self-mastery – the preconditions for true freedom), and in the authentic human values of love, tenderness, respect, forgiveness, fidelity, love of truth, disinterested service, and so on, is provided, and children are initiated into solidarity and communal responsibility (cf. Catechism, 2201-2207). Considering its all-important and fundamental nature, the family's integrity ought to be recognised, respected, and fostered by all, and not to be subjected to the unjust war that is currently being waged relentlessly and aggressively under spurious guises against it and against its core values.
