#### + SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD

"Jesus proclaimed the Good News of the Kingdom." (Matthew 4.23)

Aperuit illis is the title Pope Francis gave to the apostolic letter on the Word of God he issued on 30 September 2019, the 1,600<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the death of St Jerome, the great pioneer of biblical scholarship. The title was taken from Lk 24.31 which tells us what happened after Our Lord had the Eucharist with the two disciples following a long discourse on the Scripture He had with them on the way to Emmaus the very day He rose from the dead. At that point, the eyes of the two were 'opened and they recognised Him.' The pope's letter was written for three purposes: (1) to establish the Sunday of the Word of God to be marked on the third Sunday of the year; (2) to restate and underline the 'unbreakable bond between Sacred Scripture and the Eucharist'; and (3) to invite us to daily celebrate, study, and spread the Word of God and make it a core part of our daily life. By these, we are to become familiar with the texts of the living and active Word of God (Heb. 4.12) and let that Word guide our words, decisions, and actions. The letter is part of the trend in the Church since Vatican Council II to get Catholics to read and study the Scripture and make it part of their daily lives. This is a welcome development that, hopefully, will encourage us to read and study the Scripture for our spiritual nourishment. However, the authority to interpret the Scripture and to use it to teach formally has been reserved by the Scripture itself to the Church alone and not to any individual member of the faithful (1 Peter 1.20-21), except those who share in the authority to teach the Lord bequeathed to the apostles (Mt. 28.18-20).
