## + 6<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME – YEAR A

# "If you will, you can keep the commandments; to act faithfully is a matter of your own choice." (Sir. 15.15)

The Scripture teaches that true wisdom begins with the fear of the Lord (Ps 111.10; Prov. 9.10; Job 28.28); so does true knowledge (Prov. 1.7) and understanding (Ps 111.10); and so equally does the fountain of life (Prov. Prov. 14.27). To fear God is thus instruction in wisdom (Prov. 15.33) and is strong confidence (Prov. 14.26; Job 4.6;). It prolongs (Prov. 10.27) and leads to life, and "they who have it rest satisfied, untouched by harm" (Prov. 19.23). Riches, honour, and life are its rewards (Prov. 22.4). This fear is not the distressing emotion that is caused in us by a perceived – whether real or imagined - impending danger, pain, evil, or threat to our wellbeing. From all unspiritual fears, God through perfect love has already delivered us (Ps 34.4; Lk 1.74; Heb. 2.15; 1 Jn 4.1), for the Spirit He has given us is not the spirit of timidity or of slavery, leading us back into fear, but the spirit of power, love, and self-control (2 Tim. 1.7; Rom. 8.15). No; the fear of the Lord is a holy fear. It is taught and learned and understood (Ps 34.11; Prov. 2.5). It means hatred of evil (Prov. 8.13), and keeping God's commandments (Eccl. 12.13), the commandments which themselves are within the reach and power of every one of us to keep (Deut. 30.11). Mature Christians strive to faithfully serve God and keep His commandments, not because they fear having to burn for ever in hell if they do not, but out of the love they have for God who loves them unconditionally, and whom they seek to please out of their love of Him. Those who thus fear the Lord are blessed (Ps 112.1; 128.1,4) and ultimately "avoid the snares of death" (Prov. 14.27).
