+ ASSUMPTION OF BVM - YEAR A

"Blessed is she who believed that what was spoken to her from the Lord would be fulfilled." (Lk 1.45)

The Assumption of Virgin Mary was dogmatically defined and promulgated by Pope Pius XII on 1 November 1950. The definition followed that of her Immaculate Conception in 1854 by Pius IX. Long before then, the Council of Ephesus had in AD 325 defined her as *Theotokos* – the Mother of God. From that motherhood came her identity as the Mother also of the Church. All these dogmas about her flow into each other and form a single statement about her. She had the singular privilege of being chosen from all eternity by God to be the mother of God-made-flesh (Jn 1.14). That she might be the worthy mother of "the Son of the Most High" (Lk 1.32) Who was called "holy, the Son of God" (Lk 1.35), Mary was preserved from every stain of sin, from the first, till the last moment of her earthly life. For that purpose, she was the only person in all of humanity to be "full of grace" (Lk 1.28). The eternal Word of God suffered death in His flesh, but the flesh which He took from that of Virgin Mary did not experience corruption after His death (Acts 2.31); instead, it was raised in power, imperishable, immortal, spiritual (1 Cor. 15.42-56), and glorious (Phil. 3.21). Since it was impossible for Him to know corruption in His body, it was equally impossible that His mother from whom He took His body would experience the corruption of her body. Thus, at the end of her earthly life, she definitively overcame the grave by the grace of her Son's resurrection, and was assumed body and soul into the glory of heaven. In her own case, and as an example of the hope to which we are called, death and the corruption of the grave were in victory completely swallowed up (1 Cor. 15.55).

READINGS AT SUNDAY MASS
