""I have made ready My dinner . . . come to the marriage feast." (Matthew 22.4)

The Eucharist is known by various names. It is called 'The Lord's Supper', 'The Last Supper', 'The Supper of the Lamb', 'The Table of the Lord', the 'Bread of Life' (Jn. 6.35, 48), the 'Feast of the Lamb', the 'Banquet of Eternal Life', and so on. By whatever name it is known, one thing is clear: the sacrament embodies the idea and the reality of a great banquet, a feast and a celebration, a very happy occasion brimming with merriment, joy, and an abundance of every good thing, with so much for everyone to eat and drink, get nourished, and be completely satisfied. Another important feature of this celebratory occasion is that it is for everyone, with the invitation extended to all (Rev. 19.9). In reality, however, not everyone accepts the invite, and not all who attend the occasion benefit from its richness. Attending the occasion and worthily partaking of its sacred meal is to have eternal life (Jn 6.54). On the contrary, not to attend the occasion and partake of the meal is to have no life (Jn 6.53). Similarly, to attend the occasion and unworthily partake of the meal is to eat and drink judgement upon oneself (1 Cor. 11.29). We attend the occasion by being active members of the Eucharistic assembly, and we worthily partake of the sacred meal by receiving the Eucharist always in a state of grace, so as to be ourselves transformed into a Eucharistic people. Receiving Holy Communion with mortal sin in our conscience is to receive the sacrament unworthily. It is like attending a wedding feast without 'a wedding garment' of grace. The man who did so in today's gospel parable was fished out, bound hand and foot, and "cast into the outer darkness", to weep and gnash his teeth (Mt 22.12-13).
