"Speak, Lord, for Your servant hears." 1 Sam. 3.9)

We learn from the Scripture that "faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes from the preaching of Christ" (Rom. 10.17). Hearing in this sense does not mean hearing mere sounds with our ears, but hearing sounds with meaning, hearing with our hearts and with understanding, taking in what we hear, so it can take root in us and bear its fruit. To hear in this way, we need to listen with attention. But we cannot listen while we are talking or full of noise. God speaks to us all the time – in and through each person we meet, and every event and experience of our life. In one major respect, the Israelites of the time of God's public revelation differed from all other peoples; guided by the Holy Spirit, they saw the hand of God in all that happened to them - in their experience of abundance, success, victory, liberation, and peace, but also in that of failure, famine, war, and hardship. Their national consciousness was such that they saw in their collective experience a revelation of God's will, and an instruction for their life. They saw all that experience from the viewpoint of their relationship with God. In and through the experience seen in that perspective, the Holy Spirit revealed God's holy will and generated the sacred Scripture. We are at a very critical point in our history. Someone has asked – and rightly – what God is saying to us in and through the pandemic, whether by the global devastating activity of that microscope virus, He is showing up the folly of human wisdom (1 Cor. 3.19), and the weakness of human might (cf. Lk 1.46-56). Whatever it is, He is most certainly saying something to us. We can grasp that message only when we truly listen and keep Him in the discussion on this issue.

2021 RCIA Programme: The programme is for any adult – baptised or unbaptised – who wants to become a Catholic, and for Catholics who are no longer young children, but are yet to make their First Holy Communion or Confirmation. All interested candidates are still requested to collect, complete, and return the forms to the parish office.

BOOKING OF MASS: The Holy Mass is Our Lord's perfect prayer, our greatest and most efficacious prayer. In offering it we unite ourselves and our intentions with the Lord in praise, in thanksgiving, and in petition. If you

wish to have a Holy Mass offered for any intention of yours, please contact the parish office or complete the **Mass Intention envelope** at the back of the church and give it to the priest. The diocese encourages a voluntary offering of £10 for each Mass intention.

New National Lockdown: Communal worship (including Mass, prayer, baptism, funeral, etc.) continues to be allowed in the current lockdown. While attending the event, please observe these guidelines:

- Face covering must be worn at all times while inside the church, unless you are exempt;
- Maintain social distancing at all times;
- Sanitise you hands while entering and leaving the church;
- Follow the instructions of stewards;
- Do not mingle with anyone outside your household or support bubble;
- Mass may be attended by the number of people up to the church's capacity, allowing for social distancing;
- There should be no congregational singing;
- No more than six people should attend baptisms outside of Mass;
- Weddings planned for the next 6 weeks should be postponed;
- Classes for First Holy Communion and Confirmation should be online;
- The church should be cleaned after use.
