+ CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY - YEAR B

This is My Blood of the new covenant, which is poured out *for many.* (Mark 14.24)

In keeping with the long-held belief, teaching, practice, and tradition of the Church, Pope Leo XIII holds that the Mass is the Eucharistic Sacrifice of the true Body and Blood of Christ on the altar. We speak of the Sacrifice of the Mass, meaning that the Eucharist which is the Sacrament of the Lord's Body and Blood is the 'true, real, and proper sacrifice'. Thus, Mass neither intrinsically complements nor independently adds to, but is one and the same as the Sacrifice of the Lord on the Cross. By this sacrifice, the Lamb of God, Whose Body was broken (Mt 26.26; Mk 14.22-23; Lk 22.19), and His Blood poured out (Mt 26.28; Mk 14.24; Lk 22.20), literally on the Cross (Jn 19.34), is mystically offered and slain under the forms of bread and wine. Being a proper sacrifice the Mass, thus, verifies in itself these 4 essential elements: (1) the sacrificial gift, which is the Lord Himself, the Lamb Who was slain (Rev. 13.8); (2) the minister, principally the Lord Himself, the eternal High Priest (Heb. 6.20; 5.7) Who in the priest now offers the sacrifice; (3) a sacrificial action, realised in the Lord sacrificing Himself once for all (Heb. 7.27; 9.14) by laying down His life (Jn 10.18; 15.13; Eph. 5.25; 1 Jn 3.16-20); and (4) the sacrificial end, primarily the glory of God through adoration, thanksgiving, prayer, and expiation (Mt 26.28; Rom. 3.25; 8.3; Heb. 9.13-14; 1 Jn 2.2; 4.10). By this sacrifice, we are made righteous (Rom. 5.9). It differs from the unbloody, figurative sacrifice of praise (Heb. 13.15), jubilation (Ps 26.6), our lips (Hos. 14.3), mercy (Sir. 35.4), or prayer and invocation (Ps 140.2) we are invited to offer to God every day
