+ 21ST SUNDAY – YEAR B

This is a hard saying; who can listen to it? And they drew back and no longer went about with Him. (Jn 6.60,66)

The gospel is typically uncompromising in its message and in the truth it teaches. It does not bend to suit anyone's wishes or interests or circumstances; of course, it is not meant to. It rather provides the stable and reliable standard for true life. Take it or leave it is the way it usually presents itself. To some people, at least some (if not most) of its prescripts are very problematic, some are unreasonable in their demands, and yet some make no sense at all especially to those who are wise in their own eyes. For instance, to the wise Greek, to speak of a 'crucified Lord' was not only self-contradictory, but also mere folly, and to the pious Jew, it was a stumbling block (1 Cor. 1.23). Similarly, the Lord's teaching that we offer no resistance to the evil person but to turn the other cheek when we are struck on one (Mt 5.39-41) seems to go against our natural instinct to defend ourselves in selfpreservation. When we consider the fact that human beings are short-sighted, that they hardly see the bigger picture and usually gravitate to what they perceive to have the potential to enhance their immediate wellbeing, it becomes easy to understand why people would find many aspects of the gospel unattractive, or even unreasonable. The call of faith, however, takes us to where neither our reason nor our natural instincts can reach. It helps us to look beyond our immediate environment and benefits and see the ultimate purpose of our lives and conduct. No one is capable of attaining that height of understanding on their own unless they are enlightened by the Spirit and drawn by the Father (Jn 6.44,69). Faith is thus wholly a free gift of God.
