## + 30<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY – YEAR B

"Every high priest is appointed to act on behalf of men in their relation to God." (Heb. 5.1)

The Letter to the Hebrews, formerly attributed to St Paul but now generally believed to have come from St Barnabas, was addressed to a Hebrew audience. It deals eminently with the priesthood of the Lord, portraying Him as the High Priest (Heb. 3.1; 4.14). This priesthood belongs to the order of Melchizedek (Heb. 5.6; 6.20; 7.17). It fulfils the ancient prophesy of Ps 110.4. It is uniquely eternal and rests on the power of an indestructible life (Heb. 7.16). It is superior to that of Aaron and all others (Heb. 8.1-2, 6). The sacrifice the Lord offers as High Priest was offered once for all (Heb. 7.27; 9.25-26) for our sin (Heb. 10.12) and exceeds all other sacrifices (Heb. 9.13-14; 23). It is in fact the Lord Himself (Heb. 7.27; 9.14, 26). In it, the Lord is at the same time both the Victim that is sacrificed as a *lamb without blemish* (1 Pt 1.19; cf. Exod. 12.5; Heb. 7.26), as well as the High Priest Who offers it. Having returned to heaven from where He came (John 3.13), He now appears in the actual presence of God (Heb. 9.25) to intercede for all who draw near to God through Him (Heb. 7.25). The priesthood we have today, both the ministerial priesthood and that of all the baptised, is but a participation in the Lord's priesthood. In the actions of priests. He continues to mediate between God and human beings (Heb. 9.15; 1 Tim. 2.5) as the one Mediator of the new (Heb. 12.24) and better (Heb. 8.6) covenant. Thus, He is in fact the One Who through the priest in baptism begets people for God (Heb. 2.13; cf. John 1.12; Eph. 1.5), forgives sin at Confession, and offers the supreme and saving sacrifice of the Cross at Mass.
