+FOURTH SUNDAY IN LENT-YR C

"For our sake, God made the sinless into sin, so that in him we might become the goodness of God." 2Cor 5:21. This Sunday has a place apart amongst the Sundays of Lent. As in Advent we had Gaudete Sunday, so in Lent we have a Sunday commonly called Laetare Sunday. The whole week, with its wealth of liturgical significance, is intensely interesting. This Sunday in vigesimal is in imitation of Byzantine custom, a Sunday in honor of Our Saviour's Cross, for which reason the Station is at Holy-Cross-in-Jersualem, a great devotional centre in Rome, especially during Passiontide. The great part of the Mass is inspired by this choice. Lent is half over, and Easter is enticingly near. This Sunday is our foretaste of Easter joy. The readings, no doubt beam the light on the reason for our call to rejoicing. The first reading describing a double feast: Passover and festival of Unleavened Bread; thanksgiving for protection in their nomadic wanderings and thanksgiving for the beginning of a new wheat harvest season, here celebrated as thanksgiving for a new beginning after their deliverance from slavery. St Paul reminds us in the second reading that, like the Israelites arriving in the promised land, we too have been liberated through the sinoffering made by Christ (the righteous who was made into sin), as he took the place of our sinful guilt and made a full expression of the unitive, divine love of the trinity for humanity. In his artistry and delicacy of character study, St Luke's Prodigal son story reveals the unfathomable mercy of God for sinful humanity. In his Dives in Misericordea, St John Paul II says, "Although the word 'mercy' does not appear, [this parable] nevertheless expresses the essence of the divine mercy in a particularly clear way". The story x-rays the immensity of the love and forgiveness of God towards us. Should we not rejoice and try to pay it forward?
