READINGS: 1. Kings 5:14-17; 2. St Paul to Timothy 2:8-13; Gospel Luke 17:11-19. Psalm: Ps 97:1-4 The Lord has shown his salvation to the nations. Alleluia! Your words are spirit, Lord and they are life: you have the message of eternal life. Alleluia!

REFLECTION: INGRATITUDE: Have you ever been on the receiving end of that undesirable attitude? Do you remember how it felt? Undesirable right? Jesus felt same and in no uncertain terms, He condemned the attitude of ingratitude. Todays Gospel story is but one of many such examples of ingratitude that occurred during Christ's public ministry. Most of those He miraculously cured forget to thank Him. In today's incident there was one who remembered to show gratitude, and he was the one least expected to do so, but he possessed the decency to return and thank his benefactor. This pleased our Lord and led Him to remark on the ingratitude of the others. "Were not all ten made whole, where are the other nine?"

They all believed firmly and sought Jesus courageously when their need was desperate. Once they found their leprosy gone all they thought of was their own good fortune. They were overjoyed, so happy that their Benefactor was quickly forgotten. C. S. Lewis warns about the danger of such moments of happiness and celebration that any thoughts of God's claim on our lives seems like an interruption. The Samaritan's first thought, on the other hand, was of the one who had healed him. He was as delighted as the others with his cure but being generous and thoughtful for others, he felt it his bounden duty to return and thank the man who had done him this miraculous good turn. Everyday is an opportunity for us to show gratitude for al that we have received. May we never be found wanting, if anything, let us adopt the principle of 1Thess 5:16-18 and make our lives a constant thanksgiving.
