## +Our Lord Jesus Christ, Universal King, Year C. Sunday, 20th November 2022

READINGS: 1. Samuel 5:1-3; 2. St Paul to Colossians 1:12-20; Gospel Luke 23:35-43. Psalm: 121:1-5. I rejoiced when I heard them say: 'Let's go to God's house'. Alleluia! Alleluia!! Blessings on him who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessings on the coming kingdom of our father David! Alleluia!

**REFLECTION:** Dear Friends, the celebration of Christ the King of the Universe which comes up at the end of the liturgical year emphasises the role of Christ as king. It is also a joyful anticipation of his second coming. The feast was instituted by Pope Pius X1 in 1925 as a way of responding to political leaders who wielded absolute power and relegated God to the backseat and a call to leaders to emulate the leadership principles of Christ.

Christ's assertion that his kingdom is not of this world makes it clear that He is setting up a different kingdom from the world standard. The world leaders ride special horses and drive bullet proof cars but Christ chose to ride on a donkey. Additionally, presidents boost of their military battalions but Jesus chose a small group of men who had no weapon but simply the power of the Holy Spirit. The world leaders wear crowns of gold but Jesus wore a crown of thorns. It was a kingdom of justice, love, peace and equity.

Today, power is used to oppress and dominate while Jesus used his power to save and serve in a compassionate way to lift the lowly, bring back sinners, restore health and comfort the sorrowful. Thus, Jesus said "I have come that they may have life and have it abundantly." We pray that we all will emulate this Christ-like principles in discharging our duties. Amen.
