+2nd Sunday of Advent, Year A Sunday, 4th December 2022

READINGS: 1. Isaiah 11:1-10; 2. St Paul to the Romans 15;4-9; Gospel Matthew 3:1-12. Psalm: 71:1-2.7-8.12-13.17. In his days justice shall flourish and peace till the moon fails. Alleluia! Prepare a way for the Lord, make his paths straight, and all mankind shall see the salvation of God. Alleluia!

REFLECTION: Dear Parisonhers, the first reading from the prophet Isaiah underscores thus "there shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse and a branch shall grow out of his root." Now, a stump is the last part of a tree that is left in the ground to naturally die when a tree is cut down. Yet, it is from the stump of Jesse that a shoot blossomed. This clearly depicts the background of Jesus who was born in a poor, humble and not well-known family of Mary and Joseph the Carpenter from Nazareth which Nathaniel derided thus "can anything good come from Nazareth?" (John 1:46). Apparently, from this stump of Nazareth comes the miracle worker, ruler and Saviour of the world. This is to teach us that, no matter our background, limitations or seemingly hopeless situation, God can use us to achieve great things and make us stand out as sign of his glory if we have strong faith in Him and in ourselves.

In the Gospel, we are led to a pilgrimage at River Jordan to be schooled by John the Baptist who preached the gospel of repentance and conversion which are key to adequate preparation for Advent. John calls us to free ourselves from those earthly attachments that turn us away from God; in addition, he calls us to treat one another with love and respect, also to level every mountain that might impede God entering into our hearts and repent of our indifference towards God and even our environment. Most importantly, he calls us to repent of sin against charity. May God help us to heed to this
