+ 3rd Sunday of Advent, Year A Sunday, 11th December 2022

READINGS: 1. Isaiah 35:1-6; 2. St James 5:7-10; Gospel Matthew 11:2-11. Psalm: 145:6-10. Come, Lord, and save us. Alleluia! Alleluia!! The spirit of the Lord has been given to me. He has sent me to bring good news to the poor. Alleluia!

REFLECTION: The Third Sunday of Advent is traditionally known as 'Gaudete Sunday' which means "Rejoice Sunday." We are called to rejoice because the coming of our Messiah is near. The first reading began by saying "the wilderness and the dry land shall be glad, the desert shall rejoice and blossom." Additionally, St. Paul echoed in his letter to the Philippians (4:4) thus "rejoice in the Lord always, again, I say to you rejoice." St Paul wrote this letter while in prison, where he should be worried instead of rejoicing. Why?

We have to understand joy as a Christian virtue and the gift of the Holy Spirit. It is not something dependent on any external conditions or material things. Rather, it depends on one's intimate relationship with God. A person who knows that the Lord is with him at all times always has reason to rejoice no matter how good or ugly circumstances around him/her might be because the joy of the Lord is his/her strength (Nehemiah 8:10).

Unfortunately, many Christians are suffering from symptoms of misplacement of priorities by placing the source of their joy on wrong foundation like money, alcohol, drug, friends, connections and material possessions/concerns. These things can only make us, for a short time, comfortable or happy because they can vanish with time. This misplacement accounts for some cases of suicide, depression, mental breakdown, divorce, violence and anger etc. May our celebration of Gaudete Sunday help us to re-discover that real joy comes from a person's faith in the Lord.

Jesus Said: "My house shall be called a house of prayer." Before Mass - Talk to God, During Mass - Listen to God, After Mass - Talk to each other.
