+ Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A Sunday, 5th February 2023

READINGS: 1. Isaiah 58:7-10; 2. Corinthians 2:1-5; Matthew 5:13-16. Response to Psalm 111:4-9 The good man is a light in the darkness for the upright. Alleluia! Alleluia!! I am the light of the world, says the Lord, anyone who follows me will have the light of life. Alleluia!

REFLECTION: Today, Jesus uses the images of salt and light to describe the mission of being his disciple, thus "you are the salt of the earth... you are the light of the world." What could be the implication of this statement? Just as salt and light make difference in our lives and diet; it is a call for every Christian to be positively different and bring flavour wherever one finds themselves. Since salt is used in flavouring food: also as a preservative and healing agent, it describes the transforming effects of God's grace in our lives by making us agents of positive transformation to facilitate the coming of God's kingdom on earth. In addition, the Lord wants to use us to spread the rich flavour of his kingdom on our society.

The image of light illustrates God's transforming work in and through us. The Jews sees it as an expression of the inner beauty and goodness of God. Thus psalm 36:9 expresses "in your light, O Lord, we see light." Just as light enables us to see and work especially at night, we are called to live in the light of God's truth and to be light-bearers of Christ in the world so that others may see and be free from the blindness of sin and ignorance. This we can do by following the examples of St Francis who said, "Lord, make me an instrument of your peace: where there is darkness, let me bring light. Where there is hatred, let me bring love. Where there is doubt, let me bring faith. Where there is injury, let me bring healing. Where there is war, let me bring peace etc". May we be agents of positive transformation in our Society. God Loves You!!!
