READINGS: 1. Ecclesiasticus 15:15-20; 2. Corinthians 2:6-10; Matthew 5: 17-37. Response to Psalm 118:1-2.4-5.17-18 They are happy who follow God's law. Alleluia! Alleluia!! Speak, Lord, your servant is listening: you have the message of eternal life. Alleluia!

REFLECTION:

The gospel recorded that Jesus came as the Lamb of God who takes away the Sins of the world (John 1:29). This implies to take away sin completely both in words, actions and thoughts. There are many Christians who think that following Jesus simply consists in not committing sin but have no love in their hearts. This is the way of minimalism. Such a person believes that he can be saved by simply following the letters of the law. However, God is not pleased with the minimum, that's why he challenges us in today's gospel thus: "unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven." In other words, fulfilling God's law is not only by obeying the letters of the law; but by living out the true spirit of the law, which is Love. That is why Christ stated categorically " I have not come to abolish the law and the prophets but to perfect them."

Therefore, obeying God's law should not be seen a burden but the way to learn how to love God and humanity, and become members of His family. How ugly is it to see Christians who are devoted to the Church but discriminate against persons from another race or tribe. The bottom line is that love of God should be the motivating force of our action. Therefore, the practice of daily examination of conscience in the night before one sleeps might be helpful in examining our shortcomings during the day and asking God to purify us. Through such exercise, we advance in our spiritual life and grow in virtue. God loves you!!
