## +Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A Sunday, 19th February 2023

READINGS: 1. Leviticus 19:1-2.17-18; 2. Corinthians 3:16-23; Matthew 5:38-48. Response to Psalm 102:1-4. 8. 10. 12-13 The Lord is compassion and love. Alleluia! Alleluia!! If anyone loves me he will keep my word, and my Father will love him. Alleluia!

**REFLECTION:** If someone offends or tries to take advantage of you, how would you respond? This is the pertinent question addressed in today's readings. There are two ways we can respond. One is by the principle of retribution as commanded by Moses in the Old Testament also known as "an eye for an eye law" or "tit for tat law." This was seen as a means of administering equal justice so that neither the offender nor the offended would feel unjustly treated. Hence, it does not advocate for street justice but served as a standard used by the authorities in administering penalties. The problem with this standard is rightly articulated by Ghandi thus "an eye for an eye would make the whole world blind." Additionally, it does not ensure amicable settlement of conflict.

However Jesus calls us to a different and higher standard of life; the life of grace and holiness. In the gospel, he gave us the principle of non-retaliation and love as a way of life, saying thus "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you...." He taught that not only must his disciples reject all behaviours associated with retaliation but rather must work positively for the good and conversion of their enemies. This is mirrored after the example of Christ who did not retaliate when slapped and even prayed for his executioners while hanging on the cross. No doubt this teaching is difficult to live by, but it is not impossible. Therefore, we need the grace of God to help us. God Loves You!!
