# + Second Sunday of Lent, Year A Sunday, 5th March 2023

READINGS: 1. Genesis 12:1-4; 2. St Paul to Timothy 1:8-10; Gospel. Matthew 17:1-9. Response to Psalm 32:4-5. 18-20.22. May your love be upon us, O Lord, as we place all our hope in you. Gospel Acclamation, Glory and praise to you, O Christ! From the bright cloud the Father's voice was heard: 'This is my Son, the Blessed. Listen to him.' Glory and praise to you, O Christ!

**REFLECTION:** The second Sunday of Lent highlights the call and vocation of Abraham. He obeyed the voice of God and set out on a journey to an unknown destination. His faith in God guided him through the long and hazardous journey to the promised land where he became the father of all nations. Likewise, the life of every Christian is one that is called and guided by God to the place He has planned. Lent calls us to leave our old and bad habits and follow Christ to the mountain of transfiguration. Let us not be scared of letting go our old and bad habits during this Lent so that we can be transform into new creature.

The gospel narrates the transfiguration event. Jesus took three of his beloved disciples up to the mountain. The pertinent question is why did Jesus do this? (1) - To prepare their minds to see beyond the scandal of the cross, because the Apostles were disturbed when Christ told them about his coming passion and death; but, what they experienced on the mountain would strengthen their faith to endure sufferings for Christ's sake. (2) - To show the Apostles his real identity as God because they had been confused about who Christ was. Additionally, the presence of Moses and Elijah are authentic in his mission as the Messiah who has come to perfect the law and the prophets. The message for us is not to relent or give up in our Lenten observances no matter how painful or difficult because there is reward at the end. God Loves You!
