READINGS: 1. Acts of the Apostles 2:42-47; 2. St Peter 1:3-9; Gospel John 20:19-31. Response to Psalm 117:2-4.13-15.22-24. Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, for his love has no end. Gospel Acclamation, Alleluia, alleluia! Jesus said: 'You believe because you can see me. Happy are those who have not seen and yet believe.' Alleluia!

REFLECTION: Alleluia, let us rejoice and be glad. It is Easter Season my dear brothers and sisters, some weeks ago, our hope looked like a hopeless situation. Now, we have come to the end of the sorrowful journey.
