READINGS: 1. Acts of the Apostles 6:1-7; 2. St Peter 2:4-9; Gospel John 14:1 -12. Response to Psalm 32:1-2.4-5.18-19. May your love be upon us, O Lord, as we place all our hope in you. Gospel Acclamation Alleluia, Alleluia! Jesus said: I am the Way, the Truth and the Life. No-one can come to the Father except through me'. Alleluia!

REFLECTION: Dearest Brothers and Sisters in Christ, do you allow troubles to rob you of God's gift of peace? As much as we try to avoid it, we inevitably encounter challenges and trials that can shake our confidence in God to even ask "God where are you?" Jesus knew that the faith of the disciples would be put to the test when He is taken away from them and put to death. He therefore encourages his disciples in the gospel today thus "do not let your heart be troubled, trust in God and trust in me." Therefore, when trouble or adversities come our way, it should not make us lose hope or give in to fear or despair; instead, it should draw us closer to the Lord and the strength and help He offers. This is so because He is the way, the truth and the life; also, He has passed through the adversities of life and come out victoriously, which made Him capable of leading us on our journey and interceding for us.

Unfortunately, many Christians prefer to be Cross-less Christians. They see adversities as evil and do everything possible to deny it and even pray against it. When the result happens to be not as expected, they get frustrated and grow depressed. The gospel truth is that the adversities of life are not meant to weaken or destroy us; instead, they are there to help us grow in virtue and draw us closer to the Lord. That's why St. Peter says "Christ suffered for us, leaving us an example to follow." May God help us to remain faithful despite the challenges of life. God loves you!
