

## + Sixth Sunday of Easter, Year A Sunday, 14th May 2023

READINGS: 1. Acts of the Apostles 8:5-8. 14-17; 2. St Peter 3:15-18; Gospel John 14:15-21. Response to Psalm 65:1-7.16.20. Cry out with joy to God all the earth. Gospel Acclamation Alleluia, Alleluia! Jesus said: 'If anyone loves me he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we shall come to him.' Alleluia!

**REFLECTION:** Dearest in Christ, have you ever experienced joy in the Holy Spirit? If yes, what's the feeling like? In today's first reading, Philip fulfilled the mandate to have the good news preached to the Gentiles. Samarian, whose peoples are called Samaritans are regarded by the Jews as foreigners, heretics and they have always been in opposition. Philip is being bold by entering an enemy territory to preach the Word of God. How interesting to see the unity and joy with which the Samaritans received the Word of God without reservation. They could not argue with the Truth that was demonstrated before them. Hence, Truth and Joy are among the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Can you recall the joy you experienced at your First Holy Communion and Confirmation or at any other time in your faith journey? You are called to relive it.

In the Gospel, Jesus promise to send us the Holy Spirit. When He says, "I will not leave you Orphan...I will ask the Father and he will give you another Advocate to be with you forever." This Advocate is the Holy Spirit; the spirit of Truth and Joy, a gift from the Father and the Son to us so that we are never alone. We cannot know the Spirit unless we recognise the truth and live in it. Unfortunately, we live in an age where the idea of truth is under threat. Many believe that truth is relative; based on how I feel or think. However, our notion of truth as children of God is based on what God reveals to us guided by the Holy Spirit. May our hearts be open to receive the Truth from God and may we experience the abundant Joy of the Holy Spirit. God Loves You Always!
