Pentecost Sunday, Year A 28th. May 2023

READINGS: 1. Acts of the Apostles 2:1-11; 2. St Paul 12:3-7.12-13 Gospel John 20.19-23. Response to Psalm 103;1.24.29-31.34. Send forth your Spirit, O Lord and renew the face of the earth. Gospel Acclamation Alleluia, Alleluia! Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of vour love. Alleluia!

REFLECTION: Today, we celebrate Pentecost Sunday which recalls the descend of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. Pentecost marks the definitive end of Easter season and the beginning of the Church's Missionary activities. Jesus knew that his disciples would need power from above to carry out the Missionary work entrusted to them, that was why he instructed his Apostles to remain in Jerusalem until they are clothed with power from on high. The question is, "why did they need power from above?"

Just as Jesus was anointed with the Holy Spirit at the beginning of his ministry, so the disciples needed the anointing of the Holy Spirit to carry out the mission of evangelization entrusted to them. The Holy Spirit is given to all who are baptised to enable them live a new way of life - a life of love, peace, joy. The Holy Spirit fills our heart with the love of God and gives us the courage and strength we need to live as disciples of the Lord. The spirit also helps us in our weakness and enables us to grow in spiritual freedom - freedom from doubt, fear, and from slavery of our unruly desires. The spirit instructs us on the ways of God, and guides us in living according to God's Will. The Prophet, Isaiah foretold the sevenfold gifts that the Spirit would give: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord. Therefore, we pray, "Come, O Holy Spirit and kindle in us the Fire of your Love."
