READINGS: 1. Jeremiah 20:10-13; 2. Romans 5:12-15; Gospel Matthew 10:26-33. Response to Psalm 68:8-10.14.17.33-35. In your great love, answer me, O Lord. Gospel Acclamation; Alleluia, Alleluia! The Word was made flesh and lived among us; to all who did accept him he gave power to become children of God. Alleluia!

REFLECTION: On this 12th Sunday, we celebrate Christ who is always with us and continues to deliver us from all that threatens and makes life difficult for us; persecutions, sins and death. In the first reading, God delivered the prophet Jeremiah from the plots of evil men. Our world is full of threats against the righteous by evil minded people who are ready to plot all sorts of schemes. Today, hardly a day passes without one hearing about news of terror. This is the cause of great fear for many especially those who trust in earthly things. Like Jeremiah, we need to realise that the Lord is on the side of the innocent and will surely deliver those who put their trust in him.

In the gospel, Jesus exhorts his disciples: "Do not be afraid, for everything that is now covered will be uncovered." This includes the plans of the evil ones who are always threatening to persecute and destroy the just. It suffices to note that, Christ knows that fear and the threat of death is not the end; rather, a transition to eternity. Hence, He exhorts us: "Do not be afraid of those who can kill the body, but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both body and soul in hell fire." In these comforting words of Christ rest our hope and future as Christians: "Every hair on your head has been counted." This simply indicates that the Lord loves us dearly and is on our side. He is ready and capable to deliver us from all the threats that we face in our daily life; above all, he wants us to live a peaceful life. May the Lord keep you safe from all evil. Amen.
