13th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A 2nd July 2023

READINGS: 1. Kings 4:8-11.14-16; 2. Romans 6:3-4.8-11; Gospel Matthew 10:37-42. Response to Psalm Ps 88:2-3.16-19. I will sing for ever of your love, O Lord. Gospel Acclamation; Alleluia, Alleluia! Open our heart, O Lord, to accept the words of your Son. Alleluia!

REFLECTION: The first reading today calls us to something that seems reckless in this age; hospitality to strangers. Opening your heart, your wallet, your home to people you don't know very well is a risky proposition. And yet, the readings talked about the blessings afforded to those who are willing to be hospitable to strangers; the childless woman who gave Elisha the prophet a space in her house, was blessed with a child. Hospitality is a sacred act, Jesus said that whoever welcomes a disciple welcomes him and, ultimately God. In fact, it makes you a life - giver and recognising God in our midst. "Whatsoever you do to the least of my brethren....."

The gospel presents the catechesis on discipleship with two steps. First, Jesus defines the disciple's path; the disciple must be able to make Him his fundamental choice and follow the path of divine love and dying to oneself. Secondly, Jesus promises reward to those who generously and lovingly welcome the Missionary - disciples of the kingdom which the first reading illustrates. Apparently, following Jesus is not easy task; it involves a cost - a life of total surrender and preference of Jesus and a loving gesture towards our neighbours. It is a radical path which demands sacrifices. Choosing Jesus and following him to the cross is not a path of failure and death; rather, it is a path of Life and salvation. When it comes to choosing between Jesus and other values, what will your option be? God Loves You!

'Jesus Said: "My house shall be called a house of prayer." Before Mass - Talk to God, During Mass - Listen to God, After Mass - Talk to each other.'
