Feast of Corpus Christi Sunday, 11th June 2023

READINGS: 1. Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14B-16A; 2. 1 Corinthians 10:16-17; Gospel John 6:51-58. Response to Psalm 147:12-13,14-15,19-20. Praise the Lord, Jerusalem. Gospel Acclamation; Alleluia, Alleluia! I am the living bread that came down from heaven, says the Lord; whoever eats this bread will live forever. Alleluia!

REFLECTION: Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, popularly known as Corpus Christi. The feast was introduced into the Church in the 13th century through St. Juliana of Liege, who had a mystical vision during Eucharistic Adoration, in which she saw the moon in its fulness, with a dark stripe across it. Christ later revealed to her that the moon symbolised the Church, and the dark stripe symbolised the absence of feast dedicated to the Holy Eucharist. Later in 1312, Pope Urban 1V established it as a universal feast.

Today's celebration is a celebration of life, salvation and grace. Additionally, it teaches us that the Eucharist is truly the Body and Blood of Christ which nourishes our souls and gives us eternal life. It is a concrete way through which Christ is divinely present with us every day and moment. Hence, all of us want to live a long life; that's why we exercise, eat well and seek medical treatment. Jesus desires that we live forever not here on earth but to have eternal life. That's why He reminds us today that it is only in Him that we can live forever when he said, "I am the Living Bread which has come down from heaven, whoever eats this Bread will live forever." Dearest in Christ, do you receive the Holy Communion during Mass.? If not, why do you deny yourself the gift of salvation? The truth is that, you will never know the value of the Holy Communion you received while on earth, until you die. This is because Christ said, "Anyone who eats my Body and drinks Blood has eternal life and I shall raise him up on the last day. God Loves You Dearly!!!

'Jesus Said: "My house shall be called a house of prayer." Before Mass - Talk to God, During Mass - Listen to God, After Mass - Talk to each other.'
