## The Most Holy Trinity Sunday, 4th June 2023

READINGS: 1. Exodus 34:4-6.8-9; 2. St Paul 13:11-13; Gospel John 3:16-18. Response to Psalm, Dan 3:52-56. To you glory and praise evermore. Gospel Acclamation; Alleluia, Alleluia! Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, the God who is, who was, and who is to come. Alleluia!

**REFLECTION**: Today, we celebrate the greatest mystery of our faith, the Trinity; which states that the Godhead is made up of three persons; Father, Son and Holy Spirit. To believe in the Trinity is to accept that God the Father is the Creator, God the Son is the Redeemer, while the Holy Spirit is the Sanctifier. Each is different from the other and has a specific role but the three cooperate with each other in an absolute unity. The bible has no mention of Trinity but has references that imply it. The book of Genesis states "God said, let us make man in our own image and likeness..." The use of the pronoun 'us' implicitly refers to the community of Godhead.

In the New Testament, Jesus reveals the fullness of the Godhead when He states thus "go out to the whole world, baptise them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." This is the Trinitarian formula for many of our prayers. We are reminded today that the Three Divine Persons work and walk together in unity for the salvation of the world and are never divided. So, the prayer of Christ to the Father: "May they be one, as we are one" is a prayer that arises from Trinitarian love. Therefore, what we celebrate today is a model of our unity. The lesson is that we can live and work together as one family of God, despite our differences and personalities, unity is possible and a fundamental option. Therefore, let's use our differences as sources of strength to build the kingdom of God on earth. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit....
