21st Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A 27th, August 2023

READINGS: 1. Isaiah 22:19-23; 2. Romans 11:33-36; Gospel Matthew 16:13-20. <u>Response to Psalm</u> Ps 137:1-3.6.8. Your love, O Lord, is eternal, discard not the work of your hands. <u>Gospel Acclamation</u>; Alleluia, Alleluia! God in Christ was reconciling the world to himself, and he has entrusted to us the news that they are reconciled. Alleluia!

REFLECTION: In the first reading of today, God exhibits his power over all sovereignty, thrones and kingdoms. He reduces the proud and wicked hearted while exalting the lowly and faithful. While Shebna was dethroned because of his pride, wickedness and lack of obedience to the laws of the Almighty God, the humble Eliakim was elevated to the throne. In this, Eliakim becomes a prophesy of the Messiah; the one who has the keys of Hades and Death and has all authority both in heaven and on earth. He delegates his power to anyone that pleases him, just as he empowered Peter to lead his Church today in the gospel.

Jesus was fully aware of the on-going debate about him and the ignorance of the people about his personality; hence, decided to know the mind of those close to him by asking "Who do people say I am... and... you, who do you say I am?" There were various opinions on his identity. Likewise, we must not distance ourselves from this question; rather, we must ask ourselves: "Who is Jesus to me?" This is because it is possible that we have been baptised, received Holy Communion, married in the Church, ordained as a priest and yet do not know who Jesus really is. Many of us have the wrong notion of God and must seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit and ask God to correct our wrong notions. May God help us to deeply understand what the profession, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God" really means. Peace be with you all!

Jesus Said: "My house shall be called a house of prayer." Before Mass - Talk to God, During Mass - Listen to God, After Mass - Talk to each other.
