READINGS: 1. Isaiah 25:6-10; 2. Philippians 4:12-14.19-20; Gospel Matthew 22:1-14. <u>Response to Psalm</u> Ps 22. In the Lord's own house shall I dwell for ever and ever. <u>Gospel Acclamation</u>; Alleluia, Alleluia! The Word was made flesh and lived among us; to all who did accept him he gave power to become children of God. Alleluia!

REFLECTION: How will you feel if you receive an invitation from any of the following world figures: President Biden, Pope Francis or King Charles asking you to join them for a dinner party? How happy would you be if the invitation reads: "your visa is ready and everything you need will be made available to you." I am sure your joy will know no bounds. Today, God hands out an invitation to every one of us. The difference between this invitation and that of the world is that, while the world bears an inscription like; "strictly by invitation only" God's invitation simply reads: "everyone is invited, you are to pay nothing, and all you need shall be provided." What good news we have today that God, the Creator is inviting each of us to his banquet. Through the prophet Isaiah, He announced thus: "on this mountain, the Lord of host will prepare a banquet of rich food... he will remove the mourning veil covering all people... He will destroy death forever..."

This invitation require serious preparation on our side and a movement to the mountain to meet God. In the gospel, Jesus uses the parable of the wedding feast to teach us the nature of the banquet we are invited to partake in. The main problem is that, because of the quest for material and worldly things, many of us like the first invitees, have rejected God's invitation. The reason is simple, many of us are too busy for God and we have no time for God. My advice is this: "we should not be consumed with the pursuit of material things and forget the God who created us." Peace be with you all!

Jesus Said: "My house shall be called a house of prayer." Before Mass - Talk to God, During Mass - Listen to God, After Mass - Talk to each other.
