## *First Sunday of Advent, Year B 3rd December 2023*

READINGS: 1. Isaiah 63:16-17;64:1.3-8 2. Corinthians 1:3-9; Gospel Mark 13:33-37. <u>Response to Psalm</u> Ps 79:2-3.15-16.18-19. God of hosts, bring us back; let your face shine on us and we shall be saved. <u>Gospel Acclamation</u>; Alleluia! Alleluia! Let us see, O Lord, your mercy and give us your saving help. Alleluia!

**REFLECTION:** Today is the first Sunday of Advent, and a new liturgical calendar Year B begins. During Advent, we focus on preparation for the second coming of Jesus which essentially involves waiting with hope. In life, anytime we wait, we do so because we expect something to happen. When we wait for a bus or train, we cannot see it coming but hope it will come. As we wait in hope for Christ's second coming, we know He is with us in so many ways especially in the sacraments. Our first reading from the prophesy of Isaiah is both a prophetic message and a prayer of hope as well thus "... why leave us to stray from your ways....oh that you would tear the heavens open and come down...?" This is a prayer of hope for God to come which the Lord's prayer echoes ":... May your kingdom come on earth..." It is also echoed in St. Paul's petition thus: "Maranatha," which is the cry of the spirit and the bride that means 'Come, Lord Jesus.'

The gospel presents a clarion call to be awake thus: "so stay awake, because you do not know when the master of the house is coming." Friends, only the spirit of God can help us do this faithfully. Therefore, rather than obey the spirit of this world, we ought to obey the spirit of God who sustains us. It suffices to note that if we light up our houses and street without lighting our hearts for Christ to walk; if we prepare all things and places without preparing a manger for baby Jesus in our lives, then our preparation is not complete. Jesus must be first among all in our celebrations. Have a grace filled Advent season. Maranatha!!!
