Fourth Sunday of Advent, Year B 24th December 2023

READINGS: 1. Samuel 7:1-5.8-12.14.16 2. St Paul 16:25-27; Gospel Luke 1:26-38. Response to Psalm Ps 88:2-5.27.29. I will sing for ever of your love, O Lord. Gospel Acclamation; Alleluia! Alleluia! I am the handmaid of the Lord: let what you have said be done to me. Alleluia!

REFLECTION: Today is the fourth and last Sunday of Advent. Today's celebration is an excellent song to God's everlasting love revealed in his covenant with David. The mystery of the Old covenant will soon be revealed in Mary, the ark of the New Covenant. In our first reading, in appreciation to God's love, David wished to build a house for God. However, God would not allow him. Instead, God made a promise to David and sealed it with a covenant: "I will preserve the offspring of your body after you... your throne will be established forever." It is based on this promise that St Luke and Matthew traced and wrote the genealogy of Jesus to prove that He is an offspring of David. The hidden mystery of the Old covenant is about to be revealed in the new.

The gospel presents us with two important figures in the Nativity drama. First, the angel Gabriel appeared to Mary with a message of promise. It is about the revelation of the hidden mystery of the Old covenant in the new. Mary's role in the history of salvation stands out clearly. She receives the angel's message with humility thus "I am the handmaid of the Lord. Let it be done to me according to your Word." With these humble words, she accepted her role in the history of salvation. Mary's answer was a statement of her total self-donation to God's Will and love for humanity. Mary reminds us that this is a season of joy, a season of receiving and sharing of gifts. Like Mary, we should make our Christmas celebration other-centred and Christ-centred by sharing joy around. Merry Christmas to you all!
