Holy Family of Jesus, Mary & Joseph, Year B Sunday, 31st December 2023

READINGS: 1. Genesis 15:1-6; 21:1-3 2. Hebrews 11.8.11-12.17-19; Gospel Luke 2:22, 39-40. Response to Psalm Ps 128:1-2,3,4-5. Blessed are those who fear the Lord and walk in his ways. Gospel Acclamation; Alleluia! Alleluia! Let the peace of Christ control your hearts; let the word of Christ dwell in you richly. Alleluia!

**REFLECTION:** Today is the first Sunday of Christmas, dedicated to the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. It is the model of every true Christian family. Sociologically speaking, the family is the nucleus of human society and the place where life and learning begins. The celebration is meant to remind us of the important role of the family as a sacred institution in the society. The first reading outlines three components of a family: father, mother and children. It equally outlines the position of each member in relation to another: "The Lord honours the Father in his children; a mother's authority he confirms over her Sons." Each is important and unique in their role and position.

The Holy family gives us a model of how a Christian family should be. A place where love, understanding, communication and respect reign. In addition, it presents us with very important elements of a family; prayer and unity of purpose. Together, Mary and Joseph took their Son Jesus to the temple to be consecrated. When Herod threatened to kill the baby, they decided together in prayers to flee to Egypt. Also, when the child Jesus was missing, Mary and Joseph together went out in search of him. Therefore, doing things together and praying together is the bedrock of a healthy family. This is needed especially in our world today where individualism has done great harm to the unity of the family. Therefore, let us emulate the examples of the Holy Family as the model of how our own should be. Merry Christmas!
