Third Sunday of Advent, Year B 17th December 2023

READINGS: 1. Isaiah 61:1-2.10-11 2. St Paul 5:16-24; Gospel John 1:6-8.19-28. Response to Psalm Ps Lk 1:46-50.53-54. My soul rejoices in my God. Gospel Acclamation; Alleluia! Alleluia! The spirit of the Lord has been given to me. He has sent me to bring good news to the poor. Alleluia!

REFLECTION: Today is Gaudete Sunday, which means "Rejoice Sunday". On this third Sunday of Advent, the Holy Mother Church invites us to a brief moment of joy and refreshment in our Advent journey. The Church says to us today; "Gaudete in Domino Semper" (Rejoice in the Lord always). Yes, we are called to rejoice because we are getting close to the fulfilment of God's promise. That's is why the Prophet Isaiah exalts us in the first reading to be joyful thus: "The Spirit of the Lord has been given to me... He has sent me to bring good news to the poor..." His coming to save us, to heal us and give new meaning to our lives. The joy that fills our heart today is a foretaste of what we shall experience when the Word is finally made flesh and the fullness of God's mystery and glory is revealed.

In the gospel, when John the Baptist announces the imminent coming of God's Anointed One, the Messiah, the religious leaders question his authority to speak so boldly in God's name by asking: "Who are you?" John did not claim to be the Messiah or one of the Prophets. He had no doubt about his identity and mission. In humility and sincerity, he said he was only a voice bidding people to get ready for the arrival of the Messiah. Also, he pointed the Messiah to others when he said: "Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world." Thus he is called, the forerunner of the Redeemer and Messenger of God. Like John, we are called to accept humbly our mission and carry it out faithfully and also to show Jesus to others by the examples of our life. Maranatha!
